

More information about solar energy in Massachusetts

- Solterra Monastery Community Solar Garden in Spencer was developed by Clearway Energy Group and came online in 2016. This 20.1 MW project produces enough electricity to power 3712 homes.
- Walmart, Target, and Home Depot have all gone solar in Massachusetts. Walmart's 9 MW Orchards project is one of the largest corporate projects in the state.
- At 10.4 MW, Dunstable Solar 1 in Dunstable is among the largest solar installations in Massachusetts. Completed by AES in 2021, this solar project has enough electric capacity to power more than 1921 homes.
