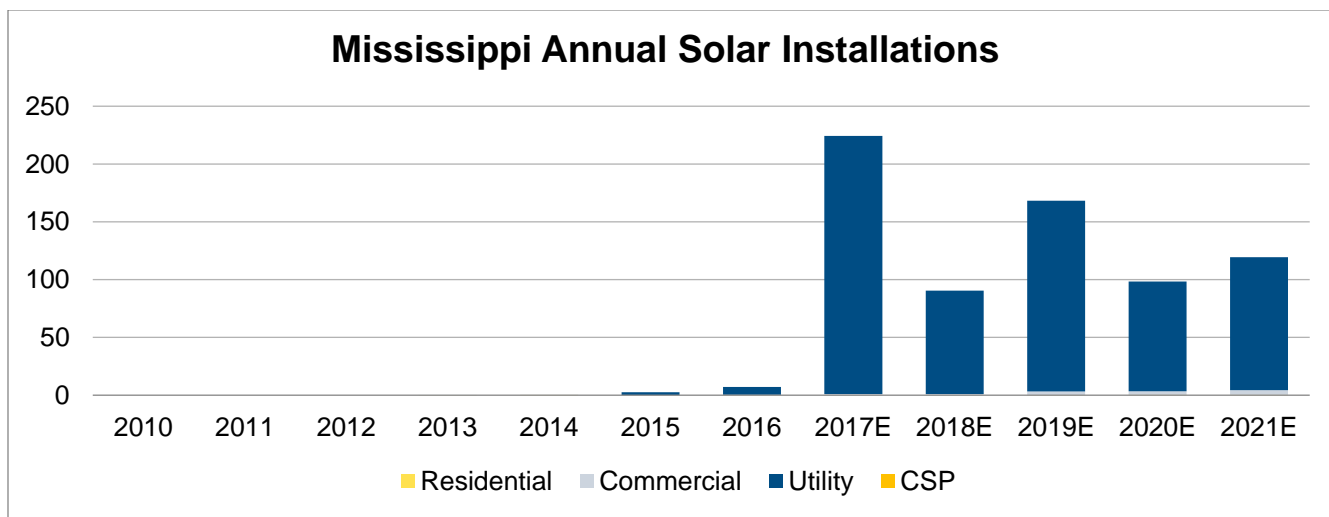


AT A GLANCE

- **Solar Installed:** 14.8 MW (7.1 MW in 2016)ⁱ
- **National Ranking:** 42nd (37th in 2016)
- **State Homes Powered by Solar:** 2,000
- **Percentage of State’s Electricity from Solar:** 0.01%ⁱⁱ
- **Solar Jobs and Ranking:** 883 (37th in 2016)ⁱⁱⁱ
- **Solar Companies in State:** 21 companies total; 6 Manufacturers, 10 Installers/Developers, 5 Others^{iv}
- **Total Solar Investment in State:** \$16.83 million (\$8.54 million in 2016)
- **Price Declines:** 64% over last 5 years

NOTABLE PROJECTS

- SR Houston is among the largest solar projects in Mississippi. Installed in 2016, this 4 MW projects generates enough electricity to power over 400 homes.^v
- Several large retailers in Mississippi have gone solar including Mississippi Solar, LLC, Roberts Electric and Spencer Pope Farms. Taylor Machine has installed one of the largest such installations at their location in Louisville.^{vi}
