




## AT A GLANCE




## **NOTABLE PROJECTS**

- RE Roserock was completed in 2016. This photovoltaic project has the capacity to generate 160 MW of electricity -- enough to power over 17,951 Texas homes. <sup>∨</sup>
- FedEx is one of the first major corporations to get involved in Texas with their 2 MW project in Hutchins. vi
- At 3 MW, Montana Solar Facility in El Paso is among the largest solar installations in Texas. Completed in 2014, this photovoltaic project has enough electric capacity to power more than 336 homes. <sup>vii</sup>
