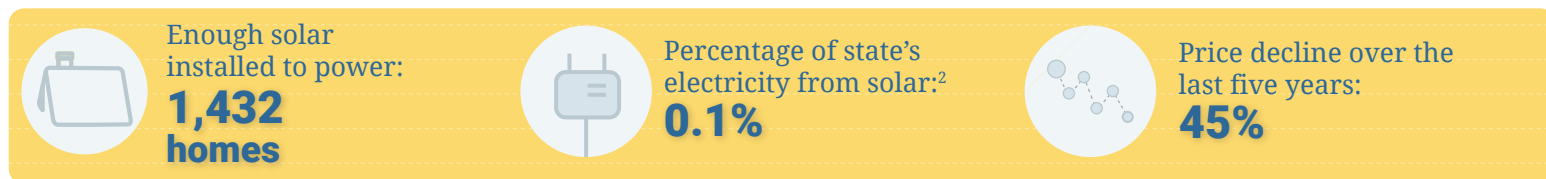
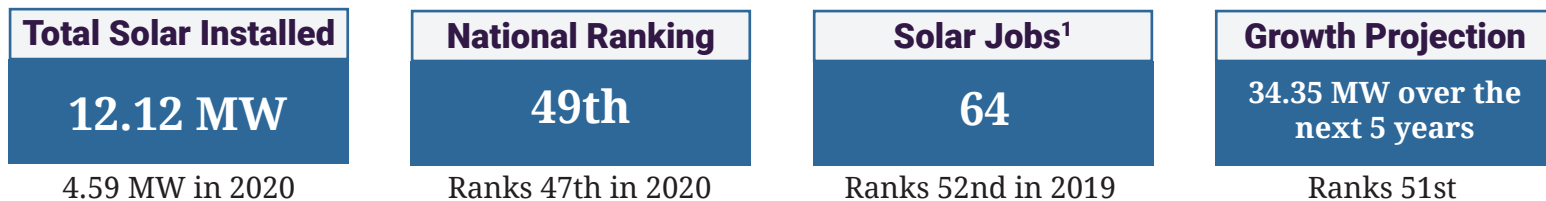

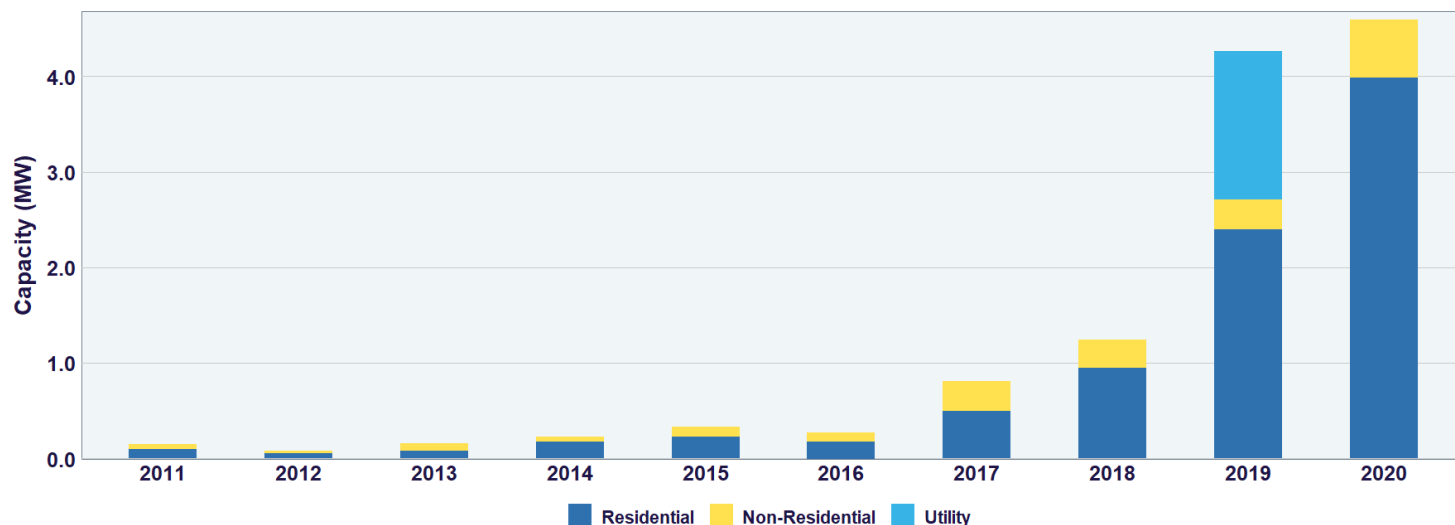

The solar industry has invested **\$30.90 million** in Alaska, including **\$12.16 million** in 2020

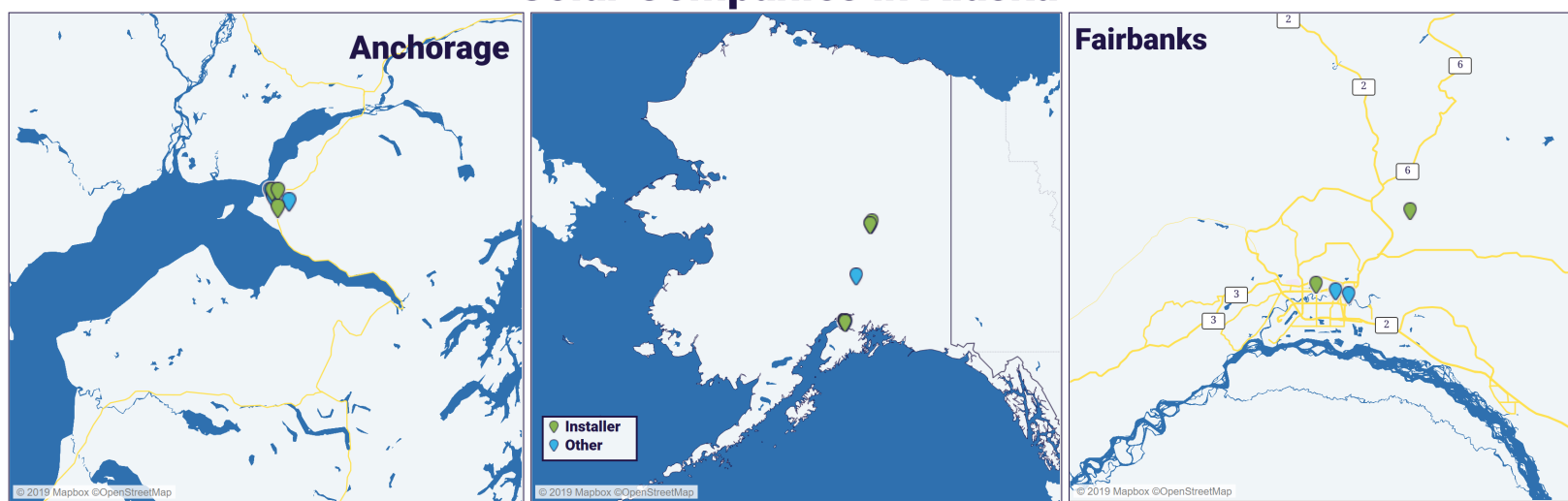
Alaska Annual Solar Installations
