

- Prospero in Andrews was developed by Longroad Energy and came online in 2021. This 710.2 MW project produces enough electricity to power 86620 homes.
- FedEx is one of the first major corporations to go solar in Texas with its 2 MW project in Hutchins.
- At 344.1 MW, Taygete Energy Project in Coyanosa is among the largest solar installations in Texas. Completed by Swinerton Renewables in 2021, this solar project has enough electric capacity to power more than 41968 homes.
