- Milford Solar Farm in Milford was developed by juwi and came online in 2012. This 15 MW project produces enough electricity to power 1871 homes.
- Amazon, Home Depot and Brookfield Properties Retail have all gone solar in Delaware.
 Amazon's PHL7 project in Middletown is one of the largest corporate projects in the state.
- At 11.3 MW, Dover Sun Park in Dover is among the largest solar installations in Delaware. Completed by Sun Power in 2011, this solar project has enough electric capacity to power more than 1410 homes.
